

You will need sustenance, both liquid and solid, and we will look after you. If you are a smoker, we will have on hand a selection of the finest Cuban cigars. You will need photographic evidence of this once in a lifetime odyssey and you will receive a pen drive filled with same at the closing dinner. 

The Courses





CASTLE STUART • After delivering the acclaimed, Kingsbarns, Mark Parsinen couldn't wait to try his hand in the Inverness area. The result is another gem overlooking the Moray Firth. You will be amazed at the choices off the tee but choose wisely, trouble awaits. Although a relatively new course (ten years old), Castle Stuart has hosted the Scottish Open 4 times.



ROYAL DORNOCH • The great golf writer, Herbert Wind, once said, "No golfer has completed his education until he has played and studied at Royal Dornoch." We concur. This Highland beauty is one of golf's worst kept secrets but because of its remoteness few make the pilgrimage. You will be overwhelmed at the beauty of Royal Dornoch.



CRUDEN BAY • Cruden Bay is a traditional links course with awe-inspiring views of the North Sea. Pay attention though, you will need to bring your straight game to avoid the monumental dunes at Cruden. In addition to the course's topography, it also offers many other novel features, including the par-4 14th, with its funnel-shaped bathtub green.



CARNOUSTIE • Carnoustie is very fair despite its renown difficult playability. Host of the Open Championship 8 times, Carnoustie is a must play for anyone visiting Scotland. Unlike many of the courses in Scotland, Carnoustie is not about the ambience. It's about the golf. Make par 3 on 16 and you will have a lifelong memory.





ST ANDREWS OLD COURSE • The Old Course is iconic. You are here because you want to place your flag in the ground claiming your part in a very long history. Teeing off of #1, you are overcome with all that has happened before you. It won't matter if it's your first time or your 250th, this is where golf began and now, you are part of it.



KINGSBARNES • Unequivocally the best new course in Scotland and one of the best in the world. Kingsbarns has sea views on all 18 holes and true to Mark Parsinen's dream, the course delivers many playable options with classic risk-rewards. Kingsbarns is the most beautiful course you may ever play and a true test of links golf.



MUIRFIELD • Muirfield is also known as The Honourable Company of Edinburgh Golfers. The Open has been played here 16 times. You will be tested by a wind that seemingly flies in from every direction. That's because it does. The course is setup like a figure 8 with the front 9 running clockwise and the back 9 anti-clockwise. A memorable day of golf!



NORTH BERWICK (WEST) • Nowhere on the Prestige Tour is there a more interesting & fun course to play than North Berwick West. You will be lobbing a wedge to a green surrounded by a centuries old wall, play into the most copied green in the world - the Redan green of #15, and #14's is known as "Perfection" for good reason, as it is a challenging short 4 par.



TURNBERRY (AILSA) • Turnberry holds an impressive position on Scotland's Ayrshire Coast. The site of 4 Open Championships and if you haven't played in a few years, you will be amazed at the improvements that have been made to one of the World's best courses. For example, the par 4 9th is now a dramatic par 3 with forced carry over the cliffs. Breathtaking.



ROYAL TROON • 9 time Open host and adjacent to the Firth of Clyde. Played from the tips, the Course is nearly 7,200 yards but none of these holes are more notable than its shortest, the most famous 3 par in Scotland, #8 the Postage Stamp. Tournaments were not won or lost here but that happens at the turn where the par 4s turn long and challenging.


